## INTERNATIONAL Immunization Schedule

To assist your planning, we suggest the following schedule for required and recommended immunizations. For your own comfort and protection, do not leave shots to the last minute!

The only required immunizations are Tetanus, Yellow Fever, MMR, Polio.

7 months prior to your program	First Hepatitis B
6 months	Second Hepatitis B
12 weeks	Meningitis Quadrivalent (Squibb or Connaught)
11 weeks	MMR, if needed
10 weeks	Yellow Fever
8 weeks	First Rabies (Imovax pre-exposure)
7 weeks	Second Rabies and Influenza
5 weeks	Typhoid (injection or start oral)
4 or 5 weeks	Third Rabies
4 weeks	Diphtheria/Tetanus and Polio booster, if needed Third Hepatitis B
3 weeks	Hepatitis A vaccine
1 week	Start weekly Malaria prophylaxis, (if using Lariam)
1 -2 Days	Start daily dose of Malaria prophylaxis (if using Doxycycline or Malarone)

Hepatitis A and B, Rabies, Influenza, and Meningitis are highly recommended.

Make sure to record all of your immunizations on your yellow WHO card. If you do not already have one, contact your doctor or local immunization or world health clinic.
